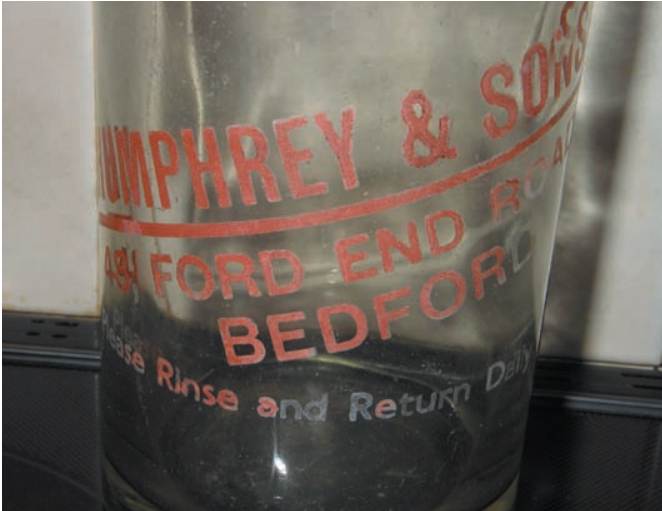


Marney Kirby and Kathleen Odell (née Humphrey)

Our grandfather and father used to own the milk shop (Humphrey and Son) at 48 Ford End Road, Queen's Park. During the 1930s, 1940s and 1950s, milk was bottled in the dairy just behind the shop in Nelson Street and then delivered by handcart all around Queen's Park.



During the war when tinned fruit was not available, I remember making our own and preserving it by using the following recipe:

Bottled Pears

*Peel 5 pears
Add lemonade (Corona in those days)
Simmer for approx. 20 mins.
Put into bottles*

I still use this recipe today.
